Mild chilli seeds. The chilli pepper is the fruit of species of the plant Capsicum from the nightshade family, Solanaceae. Chilli is spelled differently in different parts of the world (chili, chile or chilli), and the name derived originally from the Spanish word chile. The term Chilli in most of the world refers to the smaller, hot types of capsicum. The mild larger types are called bell pepper in the USA, simply pepper in Britain, capsicum in Australasia and paprika in many European countries. Chilli peppers and their cultivars originate in the Americas; they are now grown around the world because they are widely used as spices or vegetables in cookery. Chilli peppers have been incorporated into the human diet in the Americas since at least 7000 BC.
